3 QUESTIONS FOR YOUR PRAYER LIFE

1. DO YOU KNOW TO WHOM YOU PRAY?

Deuteronomy 20:4 – ... for the LORD your God is the one who goes with you, to fight for you against your enemies, to save you.

Joshua 1:9 – “Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous! Do not tremble or be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go.”

Jeremiah 10:12–13 – It is He who made the earth by His power, Who established the world by His wisdom; And by His understanding He has stretched out the heavens. When He utters His voice, there is a tumult of waters in the heavens, And He causes the clouds to ascend from the end of the earth; He makes lightning for the rain, And brings out the wind from His storehouses.

Jeremiah 32:17 – Ah Lord GOD! Behold, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and by Your outstretched arm! Nothing is too difficult for You ...

Psalm 147:4-5 – He counts the number of the stars; He gives names to all of them. Great is our Lord and abundant in strength; His understanding is infinite.

2 Peter 1:3-4 – ... seeing that His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence. For by these He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, so that by them you may become partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world by lust.

Hebrews 1:3a – And He [Jesus] is the radiance of His [God's] glory and the exact representation of His nature, and upholds all things by the word of His power.

2. DO YOU KNOW THE LIMIT FOR PRAYER?

Ephesians 1:19 – [I pray you would know] what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe. These are in accordance with the working of the strength of His might ...

Galatians 5:22-23 – But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; **against such things there is no law.**
